

German railway stations are arranged in railway station categories with regard to their meaning: Railway station category 1 of the rail passenger traffic around catches the following railway stations: Cologne central station, Dortmund, Dusseldorf as well as Essen. They show important junction stations. The following railway stations are sorted into the second category: Bielefeld, Bonn, Bochum, Duisburg, Dusseldorf airport, Hagen, Hamm, Köln-Deutz, Cologne airport, Münster, Upper House, Siegburg Bonn, Solingen as well as Wuppertal. The big railway yard Dortmund central station is connected beside the Dortmunder central station to the distance to Hamm. Dortmund takes an important position in the road traffic in North Rhine-Westphalia: Dortmund shows an intersection between the north-south connections and the east-west connections.
